CRISIS RULES OF PROCEDURE

Joint Crisis Committee Rules of Procedure | VMUN 2017

1. The default condition of a crisis committee is the perpetual moderated caucus. The default speaking time is 1 minute (subject to amendment by committee).
2. Every 5 speakers, directives will be read up, to a maximum of 5 directives per reading session (the exact number and frequency is subject to the discretion of the dais and the committee).
3. When a directive is read, the dais will ask for a speaker opposing the directive. If no speaker is willing, the directive passes by acclamation. Otherwise, the dais will call on the sponsor of the directive to speak in favor for 1 minute, followed by the opposing speaker for 1 minute. Following this, the directive will be put to a vote.
4. Each public directive must be sponsored by 1 delegate only, and have 2 signatories. A directive must be mentioned fully in debate prior to being voted on. The dais reserves the right to table, merge and veto directives at their discretion.
5. If members of a sub-bloc wish to break off and form their own bloc, a supermajority of that sub-bloc must agree. Following this, they will vacate the committee room and use another room as their meeting location, provided that another room is available.
6. All RoP is subject to the discretion of the dais and may be modified at any time.
